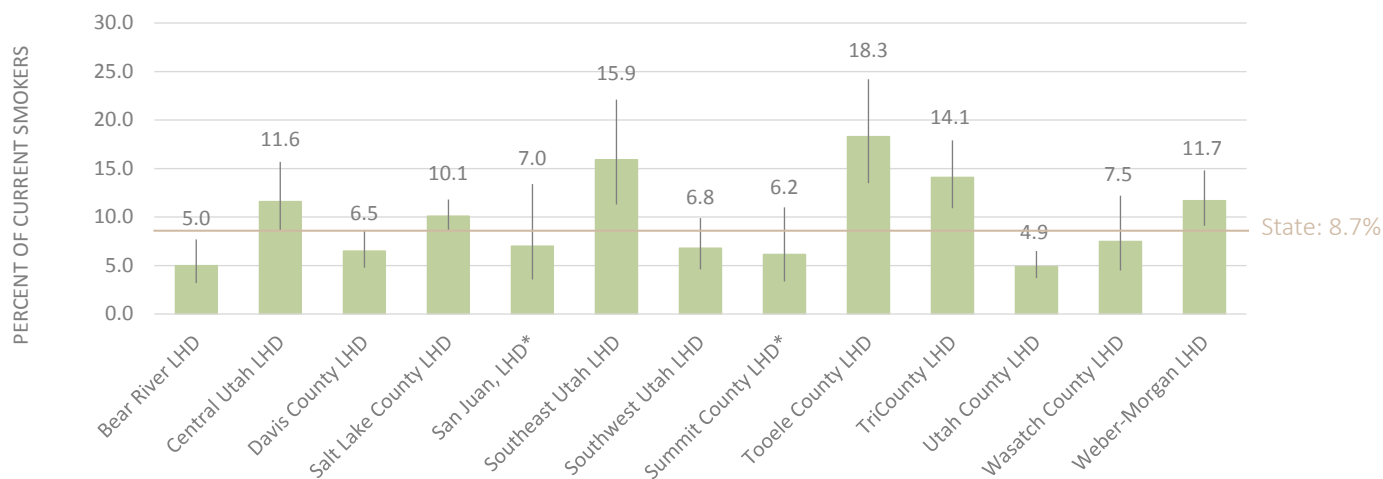


# UTAH ADULT SMOKING BY LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND RACE/ETHNICITY

## Adult Smoking by Local Health Department

In 2016, cigarette smoking by local health district ranged from 4.9% in Utah County to 18.3% in Tooele County Local Health District. Residents of Central Utah, Salt Lake County, Southeast Utah, Tooele County, TriCounty and Weber-Morgan Local Health Districts reported cigarette smoking rates that were higher than the state average of 8.7%.<sup>1</sup>

Percent of Adults Who Reported Current Smoking by Local Health District, Utah, 2016 (age-adjusted)<sup>1</sup>

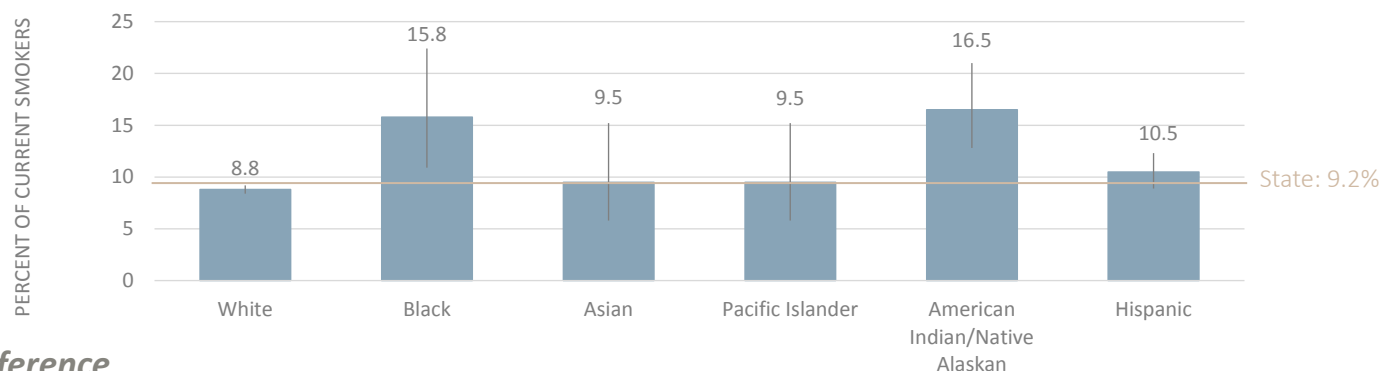


\* Note: these estimates have a coefficient of variation > 30% and are therefore deemed unreliable by Utah Department of Health standards. Use caution in interpreting.

## Adult Smoking by Race/Ethnicity

Utahns who identified as American Indian or Native Alaskan and Utahns who identified as Black or African American reported higher cigarette smoking rates than the state average.<sup>1</sup> Asians, Pacific Islanders, Whites, and those who reported Hispanic as their ethnicity reported comparable smoking rates.<sup>1</sup>
